As part of a series of additions and renovations to Monahans High School in West Texas, a new natatorium was included with a 7,546-square-foot competition pool. The 75-by-100-foot pool features ten 25-meter primary course lanes, twelve 25-yard cross-course lanes, a 5-foot moveable bulkhead, two 1-meter diving boards, and a fully integrated electronic timing system. Aquatic equipment include ten starting blocks, a pool heater, and an ADA chair lift. This new addition will be utilized by Monahans-Wickett-Pyote ISD for district swimming and diving programs.















Eanes ISD Aquatic Center

Located at Westlake High School, the 20,000 square-foot Eanes ISD Aquatic Center features a Myrtha stainless-steel stretch competition pool with eight 25-meter primary course lanes, fifteen 25-yard cross-course lanes, a 6-foot moveable bulkhead, two 1-meter diving boards, one 3-meter diving board, and a fully integrated electronic timing system. It will be used by the Westlake High School swimming and diving programs, other district swim activities, community pool time, swim lessons, and swim club rentals. **OWNER:** Eanes ISD

The 54,000-square-foot Southwest ISD Aquatic Center includes a swimming, diving, and water polo competition pool, a recreational lap pool, and enough seating for 735 spectators. The competition pool has an 8-lane, 50-meter course, or can be configured into two 8-lane, 25-yard courses and additional lanes with the two movable bulkheads. This pool also includes two 1-meter and one 3-meter diving boards. The second pool is a 4-lane, 25-yard lap pool that can be used for instructional purposes.




Iowa Colony High School Natatorium


Bellaire High School Natatorium

The Tomball Memorial High School Natatorium includes a 620,000-gallon, 8-lane, 25-meter stretch competition pool complete with a bulkhead separating five warm-up lanes and a dive well. Diving options include two 1-meter diving boards, two 3-meter diving boards, and one 3-meter dive platform with an overhead harness to enhance training. Other amenities include a water polo configuration, Accu-Tab/Acid-Rite chemical systems, LED lighting to reduce glare, and eight underwater speakers for coaching instruction or music.



The facility is equipped with Defender Regenerative Filters, Hanovia UV, and an automated water chemistry system that includes Accu-Tab. With the addition of Great Big Bopper heating and cooling technology, the district can now host major swimming and diving competitions, along with basic swimming lessons, life safety courses, and athlete training.



It also includes a 7,000-squre-foot leisure pool with zerodepth entry, three stair entries, underwater benches, a water walk, play structure, various spray features, and a waterslide.




